A blog post titled "download emule kad server list" by Joshua Wise The bittorrent protocol is a peer-to-peer file sharing protocol, which can be used to transfer data without requiring a central server or organization. Many of the large P2P networks utilize the software torrent client programs, such as uTorrent. The term bittorrent was coined in 2001 by Bram Cohen when he released the first version of BitTorrent client. It has been noted that BitTorrent's torrents limit the amount of bandwidth consumption and reduce internet traffic congestion. BitTorrent is a very popular and efficient system for transferring large files. Users using BitTorrent will usually intentionally download and seed some of the data to other users, so that the data gets more views and downloads. Since this type of downloading is non-paying, it is often called "free" or "pirate" downloading. Several news agencies have recently dubbed BitTorrent as a method used by pirates to transfer copyrighted materials. In 2011, there were over 20 million people all over the world who used BitTorrent to download illegal content from illegal file sharing websites. The number of people using BitTorrent has steadily increased since 2007 and it doesn't seem to be slowing down. The BitTorrent protocol is also used for the distribution of legitimate content. It has been successful because of its efficiency and performance in transferring large files. It is often used to transfer high quality videos, music, software, and games. In fact, half of all Internet traffic in 2009 was from the use of BitTorrent protocol for transferring legal content. In 2007 when The Pirate Bay website was shut down by Swedish police, many news outlets reported that The Pirate Bay website would "come back in a month," but they never did. The Pirate Bay website wasn't shut down because of the police, but because of the Swedish court system. The judges deciding the case had ordered a "global ban" on The Pirate Bay and they were forced to make a shutdown plan with the police. The Pirate Bay reopened later in 2009. They used a different domain which was not covered by the global worldwide ban called "thepiratebay.org", and it has been running successfully ever since, as of April 2013. The new domain name has an extra dot at the end which makes it different from its old name, making it harder to be targeted again under this law. In 2009, a Swedish study found that out of 150 countries around the world, Sweden was ranked number one for illegal downloading. The country's domain name system manager found that during a three-month period, Sweden accounted for more than half the illegal download traffic worldwide. Non-profit organization The Pirate Bureau started an initiative called "The Million Media Campaign" which aimed to encourage people to share content legally instead of illegally. In the beginning of 2013, The Pirate Market was shut down by Swedish police as well as another site which sold stolen credit cards, called "Reseller Club". Reseller Club had 3.5 million members in Sweden alone.
